NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Villiage Board of Trustees of the Village of Victory, Saratoga County, New York at the Village Office in the Village of Victory on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 1988, at 7:00 P.M., in the matter of a proposed local law entitled "Unregistered Motor Vehicle Ordinance".

In general this proposed law would regulate the number of unregistered motor vehicles in the Village of Victory.

NOTICE IS GIVEN FURTHER that at the public hearing above mentioned all interested persons will be heard. A copy of the proposed local law is available for inspection and distribution at the Office of the Village Clerk of the Village of Victory and may be distributed and read by any person interested therein.

VILLAGE OF VICTORY

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this local law is to promote and preserve the health, welfare and property of the residents of the Village of Victory, New York, by restricting the number of unregistered vehicles on properties in the Village.

2. DEFINITIONS

Owner: Any person, corporation, or other legal entity, owning a parcel of land in the Village of Victory.

Tenant: Anyone who rents or resides on premises within the Village of Victory.

Unregistered Vehicle: Any motor vehicle or motor vehicle chassis or part of such chassis which does not have an unobscured, current motor vehicle registration sticker affixed for a period of more than 10 days.

Motor vehicle business: A motor vehicle repair shop or auto salvage business or auto dealership, at which at least one person works full time.

New vehicle: A motor vehicle which has not previously been sold at retail.

3. PROHIBITIONS

No owner or tenant shall have more than one unregistered vehicle on any parcel of land in the Village of Victory except for unregistered vehicles wholly within a building and except for motor vehicle businesses. Motor vehicle businesses shall conceal from street view, by fence or otherwise, unregistered vehicles except new vehicles or used vehicles capable of passing motor vehicle inspection requirements and offered for sale. No auto salvage business not presently existing shall be established in the Village of Victory.

4. PENALTIES

Any owner or tenant who is found guilty of violating any provision of this local law shall be subject to a fine of \$25.00 per unregistered vehicle. Each every month in which such violation occurs shall constitute a separate violation.

5. SEVERABILITY

If any clause of this local law shall hereafter be found invalid, such invalidity shall not invalidate any other provision hereunder.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect thirty days after it is filed with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
