VILLAGE OF VICTORY

LOCAL LAW #2 OF 2003

A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED: "GAMES OF CHANCE LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF VICTORY"

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Victory as follows:

SECTION ONE

TITLE

This Local Law shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Village of Victory, and may be cited as Village of Victory Local Law No. 2 of 2003 ("VOV LL 2003-2").

SECTION TWO

DEFINITIONS

"Authorized Organization" shall mean an "authorized organization" as defined by subdivision 4 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

"Games of Chance" shall mean a "game of chance" as defined in subdivision 3 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

SECTION THREE

GAMES OF CHANCE AUTHORIZED

Authorized Organizations may, upon obtaining a license from the Village Clerk, conduct Games of Chance within the Village of Victory, as provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and as provided further in this Local Law. Such Games of Chance shall be

conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York and with the rules and regulations adopted by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board and pursuant to this Local Law.

SECTION FOUR
RESTRICTIONS

The conduct of Games of Chance shall be subject to the restrictions imposed by Section 189 of the General Municipal Law.

SECTION FIVE
SUNDAY GAMES

Games of Chance may be conducted on Sunday pursuant to this Local Law. However, no Games of Chance shall be conducted on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or New Year's Day.

SECTION SIX
ENFORCEMENT

The powers and duties as set forth in Subdivision 1 of Section 194 of the General Municipal Law shall be exercised by the Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the County of Saratoga, New York.

SECTION SEVEN

REPEALER

This local law supercedes and replaces in its entirety Local Law No. 1 of 2003.

SECTION EIGHT


EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the Office of the Secretary of State, following its approval by a majority of the qualified voters of the Village of Victory voting on a proposition therefor, at a general or special election held pursuant to the provisions of Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

BE IT ENACTED, this 3rd day of June, 2003 by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Victory, of Saratoga County, New York.
