A local law restraining the keeping within the Village of Victory of any animal or animals and/or poultry. (Insert title)

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the (Name of Legislative Body)

Village

Section 1. Legislative intent. The keeping of animals and poultry as hereinafter defined within the Village constitutes a hazard to public health and a detriment to the environment unless restricted. The purpose of this Local Law is to protect the life and health of the residents of the Village of Victory by prohibiting the keeping of animals and poultry within the Village.

Section 2. Definitions. As used in this Local Law, the term person shall include any individual, a partnership, a corporation, or any associations of persons. As used in this Local Law the term "animal or animals" shall include cattle, horses, sheep, goats, donkeys and swine. The term poultry shall include fowl, chickens, ducks, geese, guinea fowl and turkeys.

Section 3. No person shall keep or harbor anywhere within the Village of Victory any animal or poultry as defined in Section 2 herein.

Section 4. The owner of any animal or poultry, or the owner, occupant or lessee of any property upon which any animal or poultry is kept or harbored, shall be deemed to have committed an offense against this Local Law and in violation thereof, and shall be liable for any such violation and the penalty therefor. Each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate violation.

Section 5. Penalties. For every violation of this Local Law the person violating the same shall be subject to a fine of not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) or imprisonment not exceeding five (5) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6. Effective date. This Local Law shall take effect ten (10) days after publication and posting or immediately upon personal service as provided by Section 95 of the Village Law.

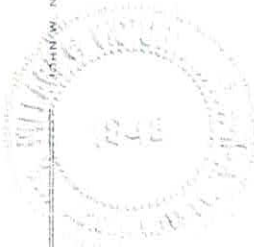
