VILLAGE OF VICTORY

SECTION 1. TITLE: This Ordinance shall be known as the Amended Maximum Speed Limit Ordinance of the Village of Victory, 1987-2.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT: In consideration of the public health, safety and welfare, it is necessary for the Village Board of the Village of Victory to extend the 30 MPH speed limit on NYS Route 32 between the Village of Victory and the Village of Schuylerville.

SECTION 3. MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS: 30 Miles per Hour is hereby established as the maximum speed at which vehicles may proceed on or along highways within the corporate limits of the Village of Victory, New York, on the following highway:

1. Route 32 between the northerly village line and a point 2100 feet south of the northerly village line.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Village of Victory, New York, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
