

VILLAGE OF VICTORY

Local Ordinance No. 1 - 1988

A local Ordinance Prohibiting Parking along the East side of NYS Route 32 from Bridge Street southerly for a distance of approximately 460 feet.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Victory as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE: This Ordinance shall be known as the Parking Ordinance of the Village of Victory,

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT: Due to the traffic and snowplowing problems resulting from the parked vehicles along NYS Route 32 and in the consideration of the public health, safety, and welfare, it is necessary for the Village Board of the Village of Victory to restrict parking along the East side of NYS Route 32 in the Village of Victory.

SECTION 3. PARKING PROHIBITION: Parking is prohibited at any time in the 460 foot area from Bridge Street Southerly along the East side of New York State Route 32 in the Village of Victory.

SECTION 4. TOW AWAY ZONES: All "no parking areas" shall be and hereby declared Tow Away Zones. Vehicles illegally parked may be towed. All towing charges shall be borne sloely by the owner or operator or the motor vehicle and shall be in addition to any fines or other penalties.

SECTION 5. VIOLATIONS: Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first violation; One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the second violation within six months; Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for a third violation within six months.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY: In the event that any section, clause or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
