

VILLAGE OF VICTORY

Local Ordinance No. 1 - 1990

A Local Ordinance Creating a Handicapped Parking Space in front of 67 Gates Avenue (West side NYS Route 32).

Be it enacted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Victory as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE: This Ordinance shall be known as the Handicapped Parking Ordinance of the Village of Victory

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT: Due to the need of a handicapped person residing at 67 Gates Avenue (West side NYS Route 32) to have access to her vehicle in front of her residence and in consideration of the public health, safety and welfare, it is necessary for the Village Board of the Village of Victory to restrict parking in front of 67 Gates Avenue (west side NYS Route 32) to vehicles having valid handicapped permits.

SECTION 3. PARKING PROHIBITION: Parking in the area in front of 67 Gates Avenue (West side NYS Route 32) is prohibited at any time to vehicles not having a valid handicapped permit

SECTION 4. TOW AWAY ZONES: All "Handicapped Parking Areas" shall be and hereby are declared Tow Away Zones. Vehicles illegally parked may be towed. All towing charges shall be borne solely by the operator of the motor vehicle and shall be in addition to any fines or other penalties.

SECTION 5. VIOLATIONS: Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first violation; One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the second violation within six months; Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for a third violation within six months.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY: In the event that any section, clause or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
