

EFFECTIVE MARCH 18, 2020

The Village of Victory will **CLOSE VILLAGE HALL** beginning Wednesday, March 18, 2020 due to the threat that the COVID-19 poses to the health and welfare of the village residents, visitors and employees. The Village Hall will be closed to the public until further notice.

Any sewer or water payments and/or correspondences should be left in the drop box through the village clerk's exterior door.

Residents are encouraged to pay by mail with a check or money order. The same applies for garbage stickers.

Use the drop box and include a SASE.

If a matter is urgent or needs direct attention, call the **village clerk's office at (518) 695-3808** Monday through Friday, 9:00am – 5:00pm. The village clerks will continue to work but the building will be locked. The Department of Public Works are expected to continue working during regular hours.

Upcoming meeting schedule is being discussed but likely would be limited to board members only. The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 24, 2020 where a public hearing is being held in order to present the village budget for Fiscal Year 2020.2021.

This meeting is required to be held by March 31, 2020.
